

Fort Bend County A&M University Mothers' Club Scholarship Requirements

The information provided is to be used by the Fort Bend Aggie Moms' Club Scholarship Committee for the sole purpose of evaluating candidates for scholarships and making recommendations to the Board of Directors.

1. The candidate shall be a resident of Fort Bend County, a full-time student (enrolled in at least 12 semester hours just prior to applying and at time of interview) at Texas A&M University and shall be classified as a sophomore, junior or senior student in good standing for the fall semester following the award. The candidate shall have a minimum GPA of 2.50. Incoming freshmen and graduate students are not eligible to receive a scholarship. (Students may apply their freshman year for a scholarship to be used their sophomore year.) Blinn Team students, with a minimum GPA of 3.0 may apply their sophomore year for a scholarship to be used during their junior year at Texas A&M. **
2. The scholarship award is a fixed amount determined by the Board of Directors and is to be applied to normal tuition and fees.
3. The duration of the scholarship is for the scholastic year beginning no later than the fall semester following the award. (One-semester seniors are the exception; they will receive 50% of their allotted scholarship for their one remaining semester.) **Each scholarship recipient shall be enrolled as a full-time student in good standing at Texas A&M University for the duration of the scholarship (except during the final semester before graduation.)**
4. **IN ONE ENVELOPE** send the completed application with an **OFFICIAL COPY OF THE APPLICANT'S LATEST TRANSCRIPT (from the registrar and sealed in its own envelope)** to the address below. It shall be postmarked no later than **February 11, 2008. Transcript must include Fall 2007 grades.** Send to:

5. An acknowledgement will be sent to you within ten days after the committee receives your completed application and transcript. If you do not receive such confirmation it is **your responsibility** to contact the committee chair (Vickie Tonn at: Home: 281-239-2178, Cell: 713-502-5791, E-mail: vickietonn@yahoo.com) and arrange to re-send the application. Note that this must be accomplished **within** the February 11, 20078 deadline. Applications postmarked after this date will **not** be considered. **Incomplete applications will not be considered.**
6. If selected, the candidate shall be available for an interview with the Scholarship Committee in Rosenberg, at Holiday Inn Express, on Sunday, March 9, 2008 or Sunday, March 16, 2008. **There will be no make-up days.**
7. The candidate shall come to the interview prepared to speak for 2-3 minutes on career choice, extracurricular activities, goals, or whatever information is felt to be pertinent to our decision on awarding the scholarships.
8. The successful candidate(s) shall be notified in early May and will be recognized at the May meeting of the Ft. Bend County A&M University Mothers' Club. Winners are strongly encouraged to arrange their schedules in order to be present at that meeting.
9. The Scholarship Committee shall hold all information provided herein confidential.
10. The candidate specifically authorizes the Fort Bend County A&M University Mothers' Club Scholarship Committee to substantiate any data provided herein.
